In addition to the writing journal, students should read a few books throughout the summer. Though most children entering kindergarten do not know how to read, I highly encourage you to help your child develop a love of reading. Below I am including a few book suggestions for your reference; however, you can use any book that is appropriate for your child's ability.

- Bob Books- First stories
- Books from the "I Can Read" series (This series has books of all reading levels so make sure to choose books that are at your child's reading level. I would recommend choosing from My First: SHARED READING or Level 1:BEGINNING READING)
- Dr. Seuss books
- Brown Bear, Brown Bear What Do You See? By Bill Martin Jr.
- The Very Busy Spider by Eric Carle
- Chicka Chicka Boom Boom by Bill Martin Jr.
- LMNOPeas by Keith Baker
